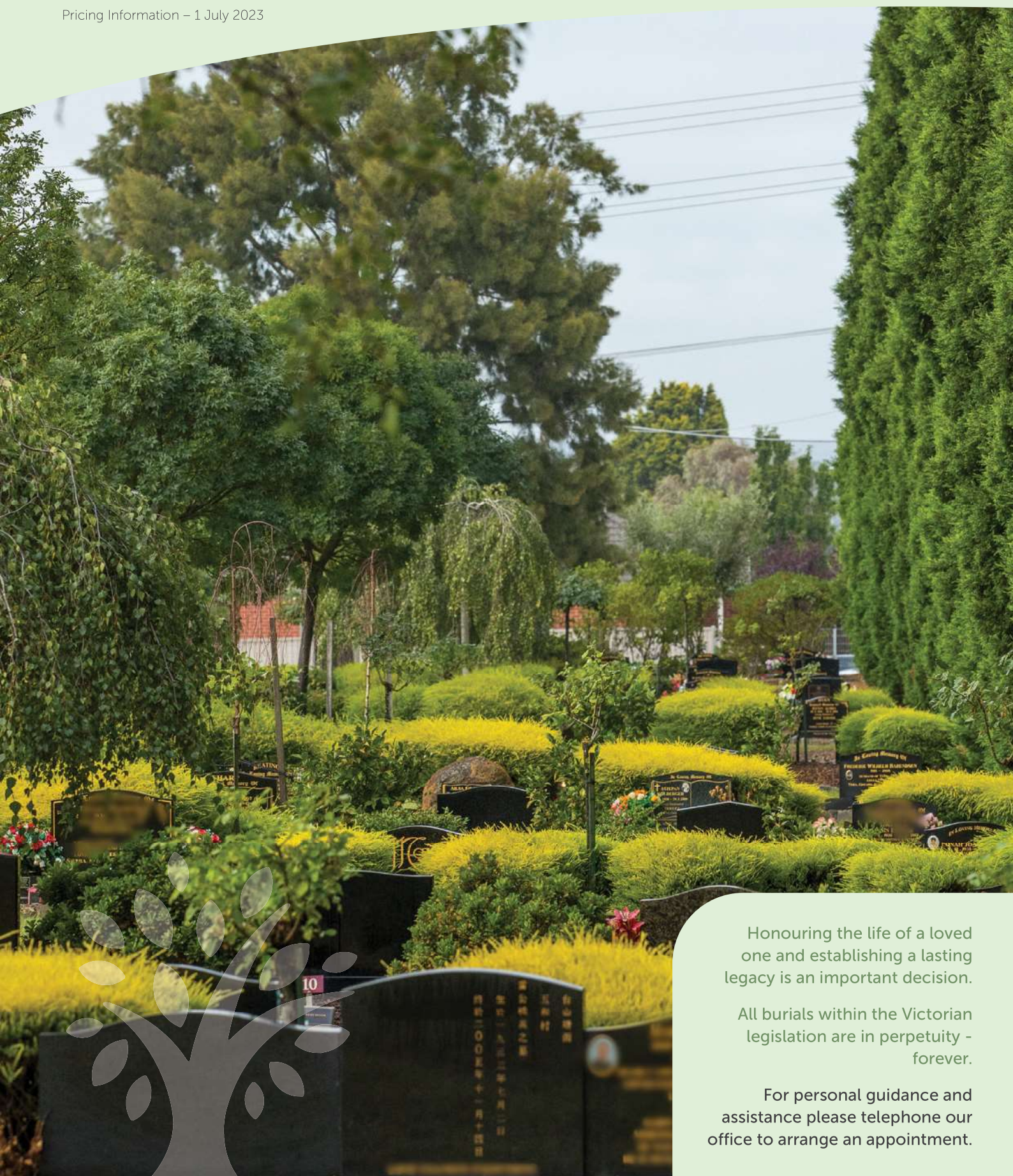

What is Right of Interment?

Right of Interment (ROI), this is the purchase of the right to use a piece of land (location) for burial, ashes placement and /or memorialisation. All ROIs include endowment care which is the maintenance of the location in **perpetuity**.

The total number of burials that can take place is determined at the time of the first interment. Three burials can take place in one location. All burial locations can accommodate the placement of ashes in addition to any burial interments.

Can I prepay?

Yes, burial costs at today's prices (including the exclusive Right of Interment and Endowment Care). Memorial plaques, granite rests, vases and urns are purchased at the time of need.

Are there flexible payment plans?

Yes, payment plans are available for pre-need products and services and conversion to perpetuity.

Who do I speak to about plaques?

Memorial plaques are available from the cemetery. Please contact our client services staff who will assist with plaque design and provide an image of the design for your review. For assistance in person please arrange an appointment. A variety of options for the plaque design eg. motifs, emblems, photographic reproductions are available.

What about headstones and monuments?

Headstones and monuments are purchased from monumental masons and are required to meet cemetery specifications. Maintenance of the memorial plaque, headstone or monument is the responsibility of the holder of the right of interment.
