PREVENTING BLACK SPOT: USING CHEMICALS

select Rose varieties known to Black spot is most prevalent winter, spray bushes with lime be resistant. After pruning in days or two weeks when the systemic fungicide every ten in humid summer climates; sulphur, and spray with a new growth begins.

Systemic fungicides such as Benomyl or Triforine are

included, or as concentrates to available either premixed, often with an insecticide be diluted with water.






